GOVERNMENT AUTONOMOUS COLLEGE, ROURKELA MINUTES OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 09.09.2023 AT 11:30 A.M.

A meeting of the Academic Council of Government Autonomous College, Rourkela was held on 09.09.2023 at 11:30 a.m. the conference hall under the chairmanship of Dr. Bijaya Kumar Behera, Principal. The members present in the meeting given as per the Annexure-1.

Business Transacted:

- At the outset the Principal-cum-Chairman Dr. Bijaya Kumar Behera extended a warm welcome to all the members to the meeting.
- Academic Bursar, Dr. Deepak Kumar Singh presented the last Academic Council minutes held on 12.01.2023 which was approved by the august body.
 He also deliberated the recommendations of Examinations Committee and put before the Council for ratification.
- The Chairpersons of the different Board of Studies presented their Syllabi of UG as per the State Model CBCS and PG as per the Sambalpur University, were placed before the Council for ratification.
- The Chairman of the meeting articulated about the constructions of new buildings to the august body. He enlightened them that the Vidya Bhawan is completed. While the Library and Bigyan Bhawan needs some time. He also expressed his constraints making it available for classes as it lacks infrastructure for classroom and difficulties of getting electrification from the TATA power.
- The Chairman as enlightened the august body the Govt of Odisha have sanctioned an amount of sixty five lacs rupees towards the development of the laboratory out of which computers for the Common Computer Laboratory and other departmental laboratory equipments have been purchased.
- The Chairman also enlightened the august body sanctioned around 13 regular posts in various subjects by the Government of Odisha.
- Academic Bursar enlightened about the newly opened courses in 2022-23 and 2023-2024 and it has attracted a good number of students this year.

- Academic Bursar also expressed that the syllabi of the PG level was approved
 per affiliating University i.e. One University to have one structure and hence the
 syllabi of our PG courses are adopted as per the Sambalpur University
 structure.
- The Head of Journalism and Mass Communication, Sri Abhash Kumar Hota, emphasized that in PG the interdisciplinary paper is pointless. However, Prof. Paltasingh brought up that the Interdisciplinary Courses (IDC) is to expose students to various disciplines, which is a requirement under the NEP 2020.
- Discussion regarding the inclusion of "Environmental Studies and Disaster Management" (ENDM) in PG level to this Prof. Paltasingh expressed that it being is most concerned topic worldwide so, it is utmost important to be taught at every level.
- Dr Pravat Mallick enquired about the progression of passing out students and the Chairman elaborated that the information is being collected and well documented.
- Various members raised an issue regarding Research Methodology as a paper for PG courses. Prof. Paltasingh insisted that introduction of research methodology being a common and useful course each subject and has own process and she insisted to raise this issue with the Sambalpur University.



MINUTES OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 06.05.2019 AT 12:30 PM.

However, only one of the alternatives of DSE and SEC are to be kept in the syllabi in UG as decided in the meeting of 12.06.2019.

Next, the Academic Bursar proposed to include some modules of the Odisha State Open University as extra credit in the U.G. Curriculum after due approval of Sambalpur University. Prof. Sanjat Sahoo and Dr.A.K.Dasmohapatra assured the Council to extend all help for this effort.

Hon'ble member Dr.Pravat Kumar Mallick congratulated the staff in general and the Principal in particular to have taken the initiative for re-accreditation by NAAC and the marathon Seminar Week in the last part of December, 2018. He was also joined by Prof. Sahoo. He suggested to continue the seminar week every year.

Academic Bursar requested the Hob'ble member from industry Mr. Agrawal to suggest portions to be included in Commerce Stream which may increase the employability of students in local industries. Mr. Agrawal assured to do so after consultation with his industrialist friends.

Mr. Sadananda Sahoo, hon'ble member from law raised the problem faced by guest faculties to which the Principal replied his helplessness in their regard.

Academic Council approved Model Syllabi for UG Courses from Academic Session, 2019-20 as per directive issued by Dept. of Higher, Education, Govt. of Odisha, Bhubaneswar vide letter No. 7354/HE, Dt. 26.03.2019.

Prof. A.K.Dasmohapatra suggested the Principal and Staff to start work in real earnest for the next NAAC re-accreditation. He also suggested to try to publish paper at least in UGC approved Journals, which is a bit easier. He suggested to try to start Tourism, Entrepreneurship Management as Diploma Course. He also requested the Principal to encourage the Staff to go for refresher courses as frequently as possible.

Prof. S.K. Sahoo advised to start research from small local issues in all streams including Science. Even literature review can be published in Journals as paper.

Prof. Dasmohapatra requested the Principal and Staff to leave a legacy to the next generation.

Problems in registering for Ph.D in Universities was discussed by Dr. P.K. Mallick, Prof. Dasmohapatra & Prof. Sahoo, Dr. Bijay Ku. Behera, HOD, Hindi enquired about applying for Research Centre in Hindi and was asked to apply to the University College Development Council.

Advocate Sadananda Sahoo requested the Staff to be more active in different social organization of the locality.

The following Resolutions were made:

- 1) Approval should be taken from Sambalpur University for extra credit course in U.G after MOU with OSOU.
- 2) Seminar week should be arranged every year.
- 3) New modules may be added to the current syllabi after receiving suggestion from local industries.
- 4) Preparation for next NAAC should be started immediately.
- 5) More emphasis should be given to Research & paper publication by staff.
- 6) Annual Academic Activity Calendar should be published in the beginning of the session i.e June/July.

The meeting came to an end with a vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Biswanath Parija, hon'ble member.
